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
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













































































































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


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

































































ELLO, nieces and nephews everywhere!

"No, it wasn't," said Willipus, " and I feel sick and awful ashamed."


"Well," said Mr. Wallipus,

being a 'cash-flasher.'"


"Oh it will, Daddy!" said Willipus. "I'll never do anything like that again."


Mr. Wallipus looked at Mrs. Wallipus kind of smiling a little as he said, "No, I don't think you ever will."

It is not smart or even funny Spending other people's money.



























